# 8 Days Shanghai / Suzhou / Hangzhou / Tunxi / Huangshan / Nanjing / Wuxi Tour

## Itinerary (for reference only, subject to change without prior notice):-

- Day 01 - Singapore / Shanghai / Suzhou (Lunch, Dinner)  
Upon arrival, met by our local representative, experience Maglev Train (8mins, 30km), then transfer to Suzhou.  
The history of the classical gardens of Suzhou can be traced back to 6 B.C.. By the time of the Ming and Qing dynasties, Suzhou City had become a garden city with more than 200 gardens. Because of their ingenious mand-made landscape and the ideal of harmony between heaven and human beings, the gardens have gained a high reputation worldwide.  
Visit the famous temple - Pan Gate. Afterwards, discover the Master of Nets Garden - one of the classical Chinese gardens. A stop at the Silk Factory where you could know how the cocoon turn into silk.
- Day 02 - Suzhou / Hangzhou (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)  
Transfer to Hangzhou, enjoy a lake cruise of the West Lake. Visit the Temple of Yue Fei who is a national hero in Song Dynasty.  
Visit Viewing Fish at Flower harbour, explore Long Jing Tea Plantation producing the famous Longjing Tea Leaves.
- Day 03 - Hangzhou / Tunxi (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)  
Today transfer to Tunxi and visit the old trading town Tunxi Ancient Street. The street with centuries-old history dates back to the Song Dynasty (960-1279). Emperor Huizong (1082-1135) moved his seat of government to Lin'an (now is Hangzhou), when many architects and workmen were conscripted to construct the new capital. After returning to their hometown, they imitated the structural style to build architecture along the street, so Tunxi Ancient Street was formed. At the beginning of the Ming Dynasty (1368-1644), a merchant build 47 stores so as to attract businessmen, gradually it developed into the distribution center for materials in and out of Anhui in the Qing Dynasty (1644-1911). Besides two well-known museums, along the street there are many shops that have existed for over one hundred years. Curios and knick-knacks including inkstones, brushes, local teas, and Mao badges can also be found. It is a paradise for tourists to buy souvenirs rich in Chinese culture with comparatively lower prices and is a must-see when you are traveling in Huangshan City.
- Day 04 - Tunxi / Huangshan (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)  
After breakfast, enjoy a cable car ride to Mt. Huangshan. Mt. Huangshan is most famous for its weirdly-shaped rocks, grotesque pines, seas of scudding clouds, and crystal-clear springs, which have been widely acclaimed 'The Four Wonders Under Heaven'.
- Day 05 - Huangshan / Nanjing (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)  
Desending by cable car, then coach transfer to Nanjing to explore the local culture at the Confucius Temple district.
- Day 06 - Nanjing / Wuxi (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)  
Today visit the first bridge built by chinese only -- Yangtze River Bridge, then transfer to Wuxi and visit Xi Hui Park. The Yangtze River Bridge was constructed between 1960 and 1968, it is the third bridge built to span the Yangtze River after the Wuhan Yangtze River Bridge and Baishatuo Yangtze River Bridge (in Chongqing City). As the longest bridge with the dual functions of highway and railway listed in the Guinness Book of World Records, it is the first bridge in China solely designed and constructed by Chinese.
- Day 07 - Wuxi / Shanghai (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)  
After breakfast, view the biggest lake in East China - Tai Lake, which is a pearl in Wuxi. Visit the Three Kingdom City.  
Back to Shanghai in the afternoon, visit the Chenghuangmiao (City God Temple), take a stroll at the 'No. 1 Commercial Street in China' Nanjing Road and the Bund (the famous waterfront).
- Day 08 - Shanghai / Singapore (Breakfast)  
After breakfast, free time for leisure till transfer to airport for your flight back to Singapore.
