| Day 01 - Singapore / Beijing Upon arrival, met by our local representative and transfer to your accommodation. | | | | | | |
| Day 02 - Beijing (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner) In the morning, you will explore the 15th century Tiantan -- the Temple of Heaven, the complex of buildings that make up the Temple of Heaven cover 273 hectares and represent the pinnacle of Ming and Qing architecture and a place for the Ming & Qing emperors to worship Heaven and pray for better harvest. The surrounding park areas are also alive with locals practicing Tai Chi , playing traditional musical instruments, enjoying a game of Chinese chess, or just chatting with friends. Then, marvel at the vast Tian'anmen Square, the largest public square in the world. Continue to the magnificent Forbidden City, a splendid collection of buildings and monuments that were once home to Emperors from the Ming and Qing dynasties. Afterwards, you will climb to the top of Jinshan Park to view the whole Beijing city, then head out on Shichahai, a famous scenic area that includes three lakes (Qian Hai, meaning Front Sea; Hou Hai, meaning Back Sea and Xi Hai, meaning Western Sea), surrounding places of historic interest and scenic beauty, and remnants of old-style Beijing's Hidden Lanes tour of the Hutong residential district (by Tricycle), bus sightseeing to The National Grand Theatre in progress. Evening entertainment will be an Acrobatic Show. | | | | | | |
| Day 03 - Beijing (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner) Visit the northwest of Beijing to visit China's most famous attraction – the Great Wall of China at Juyongguan Section. Built over 2000 years ago, it stretches 4,000 miles across mountains and valleys in the northern part of China. We walk along a well-preserved section of this true wonder of the world, and admire the panoramic views. In the front part of the imperial necropolises, there usually is a Scared Way (or Divine Road) which means the road leading to heaven. Afterwards, visit the Ming Tombs (Chang Tomb) where 13 of the 16 Ming Emperors are buried. On your way back Beijing city, you will have a outside view of the Stadium for 2008 Olympic Game. Tonight enjoy a Beijing Roast Duck dinner. | | | | | | |
| Day 04 - Beijing (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner) You will marvel at the former Imperial Summer Palace, a de facto museum of China's classical architecture. Housed in these buildings are an immense collection of treasures and cultural artifacts. Then, have a outside view of China Millennium Monument, as China's symbolic and commemorative building to welcome the Year 2000, is a gift for the world of the 21st century from the Chinese people, forever standing in China's capital Beijing. Afterwards, visit the Yong He Temple(Lama Temple) which is a famous lamasery located in the northeastern part of the old city of Beijing. It was a palatial residence built in 1694 by Qing Emperor Kangxi for his fourth son, Prince Yongzheng who later succeeded to the throne. Afterwards, enjoy shopping at Wangfujing Walking Street and Xiu Shui Market; and some free time for shopping in downtown city as well. | | | | | | |
