**Mykonos, Greece**

Beneath its sophisticated surface, lies a quite essentially Greek island. Hundreds of tiny chapels dot this blue and white-washed island with its beautiful windmills. Find a table on the waterfront and bask in the serenity of sunset over its picturesque harbor.

Day 2 / Sat : Kusadasi - Patmos (B / L / D)**Kusadasi, Turkey**

A tour to nearby Ephesus should not be missed, for here history truly comes to life. Walking towards the ancient harbor, down a marble road rutted by the wheels of countless chariots, you pass architectural masterpieces like the Library of Celsus before arriving at the Great Amphitheater where St. Paul preached.

Patmos, Greece

This island is known as the site of the apocalyptic revelations of St. John the Divine, written here during his exile from the Roman Empire. The cave where he lived is near the site of the Monastery of the Apocalypse. The Monastery of St. John, built on one of the island's highest points, houses priceless icons and manuscripts in its Treasury.

Day 3 / Sun : Heraklion (Crete) - Santorini (B / L)**Heraklion (Crete), Greece**

Heraklion is just three miles away from the fantastic ruins of the Palace of Knossos. Discovered in 1899 and partially reconstructed, the elaborate Palace is believed to be the mythical Labyrinth of King Minos and the seat of ancient Minoan culture.

Santorini, Greece

The island of Santorini is perhaps the most breathtaking of all the Greek Islands. The town of Thira white-washed houses, narrow streets, open-air cafes and glittering boutiques cling to steep cliffs, accessible by cable-car or mule.

Day 4 / Mon : Cruise Arrive Athens / 2 Days Delphi - Meteora Tour : Athens - Delphi (B / D)

After breakfast on board, disembark from the ship. Meet at the Athens port of Piraeus and transfer to the tour terminal for your 2Days Delphi - Meteora tour. Leave for Delphi via Thebes, Levadia and the picturesque village of Arachova, on the slopes of Mt Parnassus. Arrive in Delphi, visit the archaeological site, see the ruins of the Sanctuary of Apollo Pythios, the Treasury of the Athenians and etc. Depart for Kalambaka (Meteora) passing through picturesque villages and towns of Central Greece.

**** This tour includes visit to monastery, proper attire is required. Skirts for ladies and long trousers for men.**

Day 5 / Tue : Kalambaka - Meteora - Athens (B)

After breakfast, visit Meteora with its impressive scenery, ageless monasteries, suspended between earth and sky. Inside see priceless historical and religious treasures. Return to Athens via Trikala, Lamia and Thermopylae (Leonida's Monument, the Spartan leader of 300).

**** This tour includes visit to Monastery, proper attire is required. Skirts for the ladies and long trousers for the men.**

Day 6 / Wed : Athens Sightseeing (B)

After breakfast, pick up from hotel for your half day morning tour. See Syntagma Square, the House of Parliament, the Memorial to the Unknown Soldier, the National Library, the Hadrian's Arch. Visit the Temple of Olympian Zeus and the Panathenaic Stadium where the first Olympic Games of the modern era were held in 1896 and the new museum of Acropolis (closed on Mon). On the Acropolis, visit the architectural masterpieces of the Golden Age of Athens; the Propylaea, the Temple of Athena Nike, the Erectheion and finally 'the harmony between material and spirit', the Parthenon. Rest of day at leisure.

Day 7 / Thu : Athens (B)

Breakfast in hotel. Free at leisure or take an optional. Athens is an amazing city to discover on your own with its numerous museums, parks, and the shopping areas of Kolonaki, Hermou, Voukourestiou Street, Monastiraki and Plaka.

Day 8 / Fri : Athens / Singapore (B)

After breakfast, free at leisure till your departure transfer to airport for your flight.
